 Cross Stitch Strands: 2 (or 3 for a fuller look)

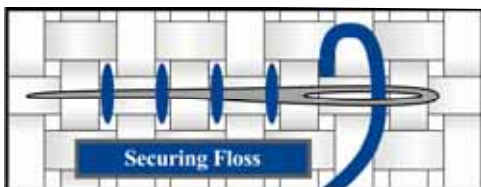

## How to stitch over two threads?

To stitch over two threads, count up and over two threads of the fabric per every one square on your chart. When stitching over two threads, it is better to use the sewing method. To do this, keep your stitching hand on the top of the fabric. Move the needle down through the fabric and back up with one continuous stroke instead of the normal two strokes used in the stabbing method.



Never knot your thread. Always start your thread by leaving a short tail on the backside of your fabric and hold it so that your next three or four stitches will cross over it and hold it in place. End your thread by weaving it under a few stitches on the backside.
